- 10. Ensure all plant defects are recorded promptly and on weekly plant reports
- 11. Supervise and provide appropriate on the job training to apprentices
- 12. Test water standards
- 13. Ensure timesheets are accurate and completed weekly
- 14. Participate as a member of Council's multi-skilled workforce and undertake other duties
- 15. including labouring as required by operational activities or as directed by the Building Manager.
