The primary purpose of the position is to supervise and display leadership within the carpentry team and coordinate delivery of building, maintenance and construction activities in order to maximise project profitability and ensure Council satisfaction.

The position supervises various field staff, along with the daily project planning and delivery activities in order meet quality and value-for-money expectations in a professional, safe and efficient Manner and in accordance with Councils Operational Plan and Budget.

Key duties and responsibilities will include:

- Managing and co-ordinating the physical carpentry team on daily jobs, projects, in a large or complex depot or a number of medium sized site(s)
- Proactively manage the work performance and personal conduct of your staff
- Show strong example of leadership toward staff
- Organise tool box meetings and action plans from tool box meetings
- Ensure quality and cost effective carpentry and building construction is delivered on behalf of Council
- Conducting site scoping of works, preparing accurate material lists and timely estimates to meet construction/maintenance programs.

- Assisting in the planning and delivery of projects through the efficient supervision of field staff and subcontractors and through the application of legislation, regulations, practices and policies related to the building construction, maintenance and engineering industries.
- Providing a level of supervisory services and contract administration in respect to the delivery of construction, maintenance and upgrade work undertaken by Council.
- Provide Fortnightly reports detailing carpentry work undertaken and staffing
- Ensure a healthy and safe work environment is maintained on worksites, ensuring compliance with current human resource practices and principles.
- Undertaking Workplace Health and Safety audits of jobs to ensure compliance with Council's Safety Management System and associated Key Performance Indicators.
- Participate as a member of Council's multi-skilled workforce and undertake other duties including labouring as required by operational activities or as directed by the Building Manager.
- Assist with other fuel related activities including receiving fuel from barge, decanting bridger vehicle, filling trucks and conducting quality checks as required
- Conduct all duties in strict accordance with the Council Airport operations policies and operating procedures
- Other duties as directed by Management associated with the efficient operations of a remote aerodrome.
