CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) COMMUNITY NOTICE

19-Mar-20

Northern Peninsula Area Regional Council (NPARC), on behalf of the NPARC Local Disaster Management Group (LDMG), advise that **UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE**, due to Coronavirus, travel to the Northern Peninsula Area (NPA) is limited to those people involved in the provision of essential services in the community.

ADDITIONALLY, the following people **SHOULD NOT TRAVEL** to the **NPA**:

- Any person who has been diagnosed with or suspected to be infected with Coronavirus;
- Any person who is feeling unwell or has had close contact with someone who is unwell, in the last 14 days;
- Any person who has travelled overseas or has had close contact with someone who has travelled overseas, in the last 14 days.
- Any person travelling out of the NPA must be prepared for the additional risk of not being permitted back into community depending on advice from Queensland Health as amended from time to time

Applications for any exceptions to this Travel restriction should be referred to ceo@nparc.qld.gov.au

THESE RESTRICTIONS APPLY TO BOTH VISITORS AND RESIDENTS OF NPA.
