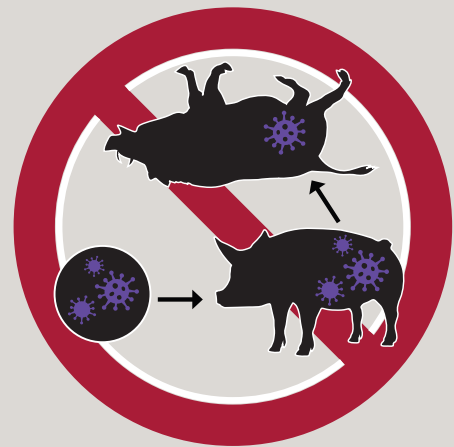




Keep a TOP WATCH for AFRICAN SWINE FEVER

- African Swine Fever (ASF) is causing lots of pigs to die in other countries.
- Only pigs get sick with ASF.
- Humans and other animals can't get sick with ASF.
- The germ can be in meat products from other countries.
- If pigs eat meat scraps (swill) they can get ASF and other diseases.
- Pigs should not eat rubbish.
- Feeding swill to pigs is against the law in Australia.
- Pigs with ASF might show these signs:
 - die suddenly
 - coughing
 - bleeding
 - wobbly walking
 - vomiting
 - pigs acting strange
 - diarrhoea
