



Residents Returning To NPA

We all understand that everyone wants to come home. However, we need to think about a few things first, like the safety of our community and the at-risk people that live here especially our elders and our people that are not well. Also flu season is around so we all need to make sure we get our flu shots. So NPARC and the LDMG with the help of some other agencies have put together this information sheet to help you understand what needs to happen for you to come home and keep everyone safe from COVID 19.

- ⇒ Firstly, You will need your Permit approved by LDMG Chair with your Individual Bio-security Plan and have it sighted at Cairns Airport with ID. Your Bio security plan will determine what is happening when you arrive at NPA regarding isolation. We will talk more about that later.
- ⇒ Once checked in REX will explain to what has to happen. Your temperature will be taken and noted if you have a fever you will be referred to a doctor and you won't be able to board the plane. You will be given a mask if it is required please wear it
- ⇒ Police will check your papers don't be alarmed this is necessary to keep everyone safe as COVID 19 can be hard to control so we have to work together at all times.
- ⇒ REX staff will look after you and ensure you get on board safely please do your part and follow the flight attendants instructions .
- ⇒ Once on board, there is a passenger information card make sure you read it and follow instructions . If you do not understand please ask the flight attendant and they will explain it to you
- ⇒ Once you arrive in Bamaga, the airport staff will let you know where to go and what is going to happen. Your family and friends may be waiting just outside the airport don't go rushing to them just yet.
- ⇒ If you have isolated in Cairns under supervision you will be able to be greeted by your family and go home and not have to isolate
- ⇒ Some of you may be required to self isolate at home on your own or at NPARC accommodation. You will have been told that earlier. If you are going to NPARC accommodation to be isolated than you will be directed to a bus specially setup for this . If you are unsure what is happening Please ask and it will be explained. Someone will be at the airport to answer your questions.
- ⇒ Remember, if you feel unwell go to Bamaga Hospital
